PMP EXAMINATION PREPARATION

Experienced Project Managers, who want to earn their PMP Certification from PMI, can take advantage of a discounted course package. By attending TSE001 PROJECT PLANNING AND CONTROL and TSE015 PMP EXAM PREPARATION WORKSHOP, they fulfill PMI's "35 Contact Hour" requirement, while learning best practices and PMBOK (Project Management Body of Knowledge) concepts. 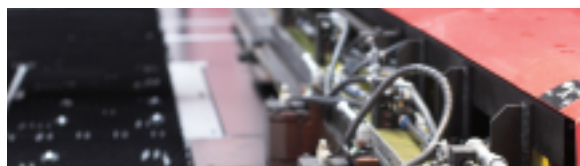

CAREER ENHANCING COURSES

Learn specific tools and techniques in Project Management or Business Analysis by enrolling in any of the classes offered in this program. By completing program courses participants who are already PMPs will earn PDUs which are required to maintain their Project Management Professional certification.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

The New York State Continuing Professional Competency program (CPC) requires all Professional Engineers (PE) to complete 36 Professional Development Hours (PDHs) of certified training in order to renew their license. TSE001 PROJECT PLANNING AND CONTROL has been certified by the Practicing Institute of Engineers to award participating PEs 24 PDHs, two-thirds of the total requirement.
